- UNICEF will be running a campaign on the account of World Immunization week from April 24 to 30 spreading the message that together communities, including parents, can protect everyone through vaccines.
- A string of blasts ripped through high-end hotels and churches as worshippers attended Easter services in Sri Lanka on Sunday. Death toll rises to 290.
- New device designed by researchers at the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) is just a small, inexpensive, thin and flexible like a sheet of plastic which can produce electricity from falling snow.
- Lori Lightfoot became the first African-American women to be selected as the Mayor of Chicago, the third largest city in the US on April 3, 2019.
