- The government will be taking over the National Housing Bank (NHB) after stake for Rs 1,450 crore from the Reserve bank of India (RBI)
- Lebanon's capital Beirut has set a new Guinness World Record for the number of national flags raised in a city for 24 hours.
- Indian Marathon runner, Nitendra Singh Rawat finished 27th in the men's Elite race of Virgin Money London Marathon 2019 at London, the UK.
- Alfred Brownell, an environment lawyer, and activist was awarded the Goldman Environmental Prize
- Niramai, the Bengaluru based health tech startup nailed gold prize at the Hack Osaka event, Japan, imprinting India's technology at the global level.
- Bajrang Punia is set to become the first wrestler from India to fight at the iconic Madison Square Garden in New York.
- Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) recommended 4 Indian Cricketers – Mohammed Shami, Jasprit Bumrah, Ravindra Jadeja and Poonam Yadav for the Arjuna Award 2019.
