- The National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development announced an Rs 700 crore venture capital fund for equity investments in agriculture and rural-focus startups.
- The Moon is steadily shrinking, causing wrinkling on its surface and quakes, according to an analysis of imagery captured by NASA's Lunar Reconnaissance Orbiter (LRO).
- Oil prices rose after Saudi Arabia said explosive-laden drones had attacked two pumping stations belonging to state oil company Aramco.
- India had more deaths among children under five than any other country in 2015, a Lancet study has found.
- The central government has extended the ban on the Liberation Tigers of Tamil Eelam (LTTE) for five years with immediate effect.
- Maruti Suzuki India has opened a skill training centre at ITI-Becharaji, in Gujarat, that can provide training to over 7,000 trainees annually.
- Japanese two-wheeler manufacturer Yamaha Motor has achieved 10 million production milestone in the country.
- Union Bank of India reported a net loss of Rs 3,369 crore in the March quarter of FY19, owing to higher operational expenses, and provisions on account of bad loan divergences.
- Victoria, the capital of Seychelles, is the most expensive city with an index value of 192 and a rank of 28, as per the Mint Globetrotter Index's others category
- Indian Captain Virat Kohli bagged the International Cricketer & Batsman of the Year Award during the CEAT Cricket Rating (CCR) International Awards 2019.
