- The World Chess Federation (FIDE) has decided to restore the Elo ratings of dozens of Indian Players, whose ratings were banned by the All-India Chess Federation (AICF) nearly a decade ago.
- The Central Information Commission (CIC) has directed the RBI to disclose the list of big loan defaulters it had sent to banks for resolution.
- Fiat Chrysler announced that it will look to pursue a \$35 billion merger with French automaker Renault.
- Former PM Monmohan Singh, who has represented Assam in the Rajya Sabha for the last 28 years, will not be nominated to the Parliament's Upper House this time.
- Indian shooter Rahi Sarnobat won the gold in 25m Pistol event at the ISSF world cup 2019 in Munich.
- Rivers worldwide are polluted with antibiotics that exceed environmental safety thresholds by up to 300 times, according to research.
